A soft copy of the same should also be sent to “essaygil2017@geeta.edu.in” before the last date in “.doc” or “.docx” format. Soft copy should be submitted before the last date. The participants will be informed about other details or subsequent changes, if any via email.

Only single authorship is permissible, any submission by more than one author shall be treated as multiple submissions and thereby shall result into disqualification.
