ABSTRACT: The abstract should not exceed 300 words and must be accompanied by a cover page stating the following: -

- Sub-theme
- Title of the Paper
- Name of the author(s)
- E-mail address
- Postal address and Contact Number

FULL RESEARCH PAPER

- The paper should have a minimum of 3000 (exclusive of footnotes) & maximum of 5000 words (inclusive of footnotes).
- There can be only an author and one co-author. Inclusion of more than one co-author will result in automatic disqualification.
- The main text should be in Times New Roman with font size 12 and spacing of 1.5.
- The footnotes should be in Times New Roman, font size 10 with single line spacing.
- One inch margin on all sides should be maintained.
- Citation Style: Bluebook 19th Edition.

- The full paper must be emailed to cesgil@geeta.edu.in on or before 29th January 2021 with the subject as “SUBMISSION OF FULL PAPER FOR INTERNATIONAL E-SEMINAR”
